**General:** The yacht was designed for the government of The Republic of Iraq (State Enterprise

for Water Transportation) as an ocean going presidential luxury yacht. She was built by the former Wärtsila Shipyard in Finland and was delivered in 1983. Special features included a mini-submarine rescue capsule. She was bombed by the US Air Force in March 2003 during the invasion of Iraq, but she proved difficult to sink and had to be

scrapped two years later in Basra.
