Chinese ferry designed by Knud E. Hansen A/S

CS Marine of Shanghai has contracted the Danish company for the development of the design of a 120 m ro-pax which will operate out of Hainan Island in the South China Sea. Knud E. Hansen has developed Concept and Tender Designs with CS Marine on behalf of the Bo Hai Shipyard in China. The first vessel construction was awarded to the shipyard by the Local Government of Hainan Province.

The cargo will be rolling in and out of the vessel via a quarter ramp situated on the starboard side.

The vessel will have multiple operating modes such as regular ferry service between ports or as a long term cruise vessel for cruises of up to 30 days duration.
