## Knud E. Hansen moves to new domicile

With a new company domicile in Elsinore the maritime drawing office Knud
E. Hansen has now more room for both
employees and new assignments. After
a few quiet years in the beginning of the
new millennium the drawing office has
enjoyed marked progress during recent
years. This is true not least because the
company has focused strongly on constructions for the offshore industry.
With still more employees and a desire
to move away from Copenhagen, Elsinore was chosen.

"Traffic into and out of Copenhagen has become too massive, and opportunities for parking are very limited. We've also wanted our own domicile for a long time, and this is why we chose to move to Elsinore," explains Finn Wollesen, Managing Director of Knud E. Hansen, who are naval architects and marine engineers.

Knud E. Hansen are now to be found in the 'Lundegården' – the former tax administration in Elsinore Municipality. Thereby the company has come full circle; it was actually established in Elsinore in the 1930s.

The inauguration of the new domicile was marked with a reception in May, and now a series of new orders for the off-shore industry must be handled, and the drawing office must be consolidated. "Our ambition is to be the best maritime drawing office and to be a company that attracts the most competent employees," says Finn Wollesen.

Two floors of a total of 2,000 m<sup>2</sup> have been made ready for the drawing office's own employees, and Finn Wollesen expects that a third floor will be let to an external company. In addition, Knud E. Hansen has offices or is represented in London, Piraeus in Greece, Rostock in Germany and Saint-Nazaire in France.
